Statutory functions²

§ 12 - Advisory Board

- (1) The DIID shall be supported and advised by an advisory board consisting of personalities from science and society who are working on the effects of digitalisation on democracy.
- (2) The advisory board shall accompany the scientific research at the DIID and the transfer of knowledge into social practice with proposals and initiatives and evaluate them every 18 months.
- (3) The members of the Advisory Board shall be elected by the Executive Board for three years at a time. They shall elect a chairperson and deputy chairperson from among their members.
- (4) The Advisory Board shall meet at least twice a year. The Chairperson, in agreement with the Speaker, shall invite the members of the Advisory Board and other experts as required, stating a provisional agenda.
- (5) The Advisory Board shall be regularly informed by the Spokesperson about the activities of the Institute.
